Christine joined LA18 in 2005 with extensive experience as an anchor and reporter in Taiwan and here in the United States. She began her broadcast career in 1994 as an anchor/reporter at Taiwan's Super TV News Network. After she moved to the United States, Christine became the prime time anchor for the TVB Jade (USA) channel based in Norwalk. Christine now features her many talents as part of the LA18 Mandarin language news programs, serving as the prime time anchor and news writer.

Christine was born in Taichung, Taiwan. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Western Language and Literature from Providence University in Taiwan, and earned a Master of Science degree in Human Resource Development from Pittsburg State University in the United States.
